Year 4 swimming lessons began this week for Year 4, and the swim teachers were really impressed with everyone's effort and enthusiasm in the pool.

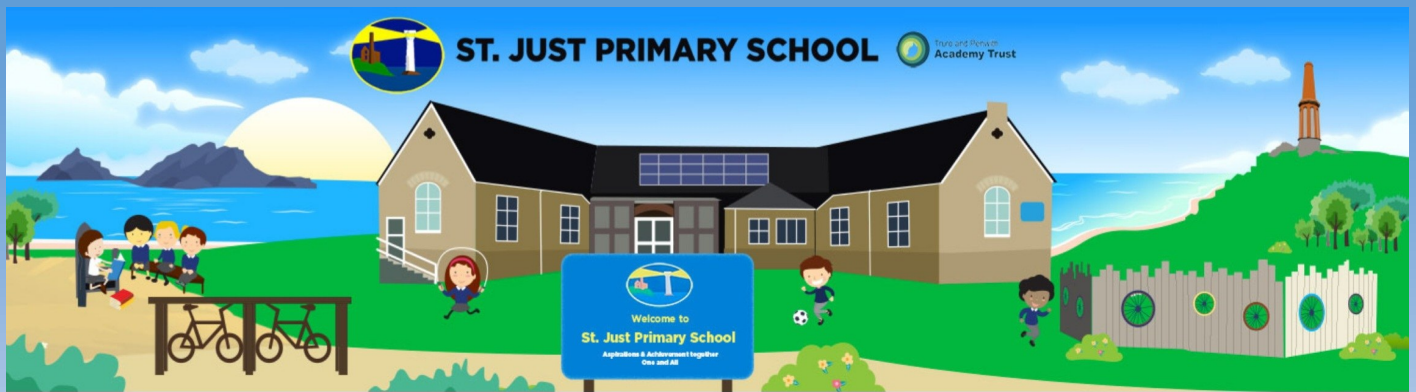

If you want to have a family photo with children who are older or younger than school age, please ring the school office to book an appointment from Monday 22nd September 2025.

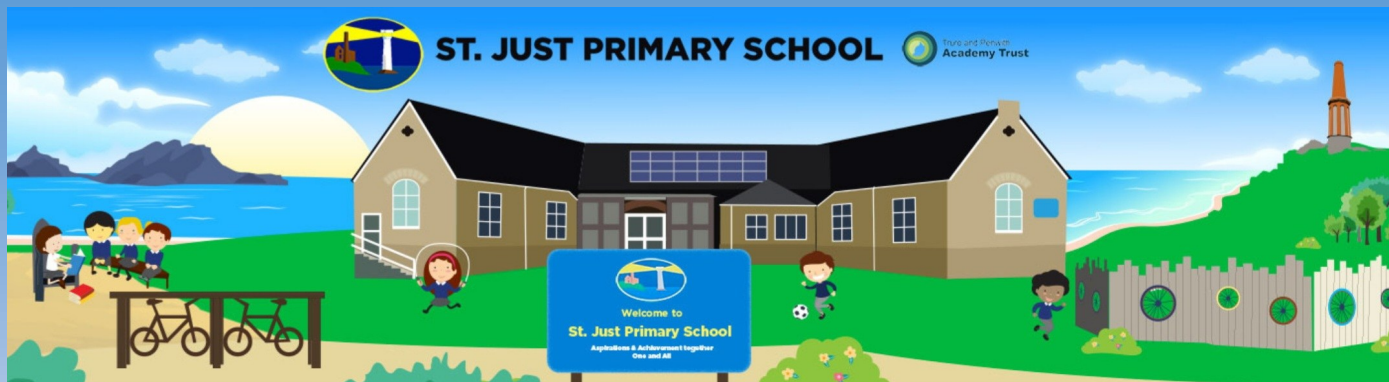


Parents meetings in October
