Below are 6 activities to do with an adult at home. We would like you to **choose 2** of them (or more) and take pictures/short video and send it in!

Choose one activity from the 'A' section (written work) and one from the 'B' section (art work). If you need anything to help you to complete the tasks you choose, ask an adult from Year 3.

<p><u>Stone age recipe</u> Stone age people could not pop to the shops for food. Everything they ate had to be caught or collected. Write your own recipe for a stone age dinner using the sort of ingredients that would be available to them.</p>	<p><u>Stone Age jewellery</u> Make a stone age necklace or bracelet. Think about the materials that were available to the Stone Age people.</p>
<p><u>Time Traveller</u> Imagine that you have been whisked back in time to a Stone Age camp. You have been allowed to take one person or one object from 2016. What would you take and how would you explain your choice to the stone Age people?</p>	<p><u>Cave art</u> Make up your own story, it can be about anything you like but tell it through cave art pictures!</p>
<p><u>Cave homes</u> During the Stone Age, people lived in caves. If you had to live in a cave what would you like it to look like and what would be in it?
