

Headline data Summary – end of year 2016

EYFS

Cohort size 22 4.5% each child

Good Level of Development – GLD 59% of cohort (National 69%)

Reading (64%) and writing (59%) are both below national (74% and 67%)

Phonics Screening Test – year 1

23 pupils 4.3% each

35% of pupils 'passed' with a score of 32 and above out of 40

The average reading age of those who 'passed' was 7 years and 3 months

Phonics Screening Test retakes – year 2

14 pupils re-took the test in year 2

6 'passed' 43%

Year 2 – end of KS1

30 pupils 3.3% each child

Reading 67% achieved the expected standard and above

Writing 60% achieved the expected standard and above

Maths 63% achieved the expected standard and above

Progress:

Maths 5 children below GLD in 2014 ach the expected standard

Year 6 – end of KS2

32 pupils 3.1% each child

Reading 56% (national 66%) average scaled score 103 (national 103)
% achieved at high scaled score = 22%

Writing 84% (national 74%) % achieved at Greater Depth = 38%

SPAG 78% (national 73%) average scaled score 104 (national 104)

Maths 84% (national 70%) average scaled score 104 (national 103)
% achieved at high scaled score = 16%

Pupils meeting expected standard in R,W,M combined 56.3% (national 53%)
% achieved at higher standard = 13%
