Our topic this half term is: Were the Dark Ages Dark?

We will cover this topic in: Literacy, History, Geography ICT and Art.

Literacy

Spellings will be focussed in class at the moment, we will focus on a sound a week. Our morning focus will be spellings and reading before our literacy lesson.

Our text this half term will be 'How to Train your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell. We will be reading and answering comprehension questions as well as using the book in our literacy lessons. We will be writing using different genre, all linked to the book. After this, we will look at Myths and Legends.

Numeracy

By the end of year 4 our aim is that children know all of their times tables. We will be focussing on the ones they should already have learnt as a recap/catch up. Please help them with this. We are starting by looking at multiplication by 11 and 12.

We will then be moving on to fractions.

History

We will be finding out about the Dark Ages and changes which occurred during this period. We shall be exploring invaders and settlers from this time and some of the major finds that have challenged our thinking about this period of time.

Geography

The children will be learning geographical facts about the physical and human geography of Iceland. A land created by ice and fire!
